 - ✓ Married 5X
 - ✓ Living with a man
 - ✓ Came at midday to draw water...Outcast

- The Samaritan Woman
 - O What did she need?
 - ✓ Salvation...living water
 - To be seen (John 4:7)
 - To be valued (John 4:7-8)
 - To be accepted (John 4:16-18)
 - To be shown the Messiah (John 4:25-26)

- The Samaritan Woman
 - O How did her life change?
 - She went to the townspeople to share her encounter

So the woman left her water jar and went away into town and said to the people, 29 "Come, see a man who told me all that I ever did. Can this be the Christ?" 30 They went out of the town and were coming to him. John 4:28-30 (ESV)

- The Samaritan Woman
 - O How did her life change?
 - ✓ She became a part of the community (their transformation, too).

Many Samaritans from that town believed in him because of the woman's testimony, "He told me all that I ever did." 40 So when the Samaritans came to him, they asked him to stay with them, and he stayed there two days. 41 And many more believed because of his word. 42 They said to the woman, "It is no longer because of what you said that we believe, for we have heard for ourselves, and we know that this is indeed the Savior of the world." John 4:39-42 (ESV)
